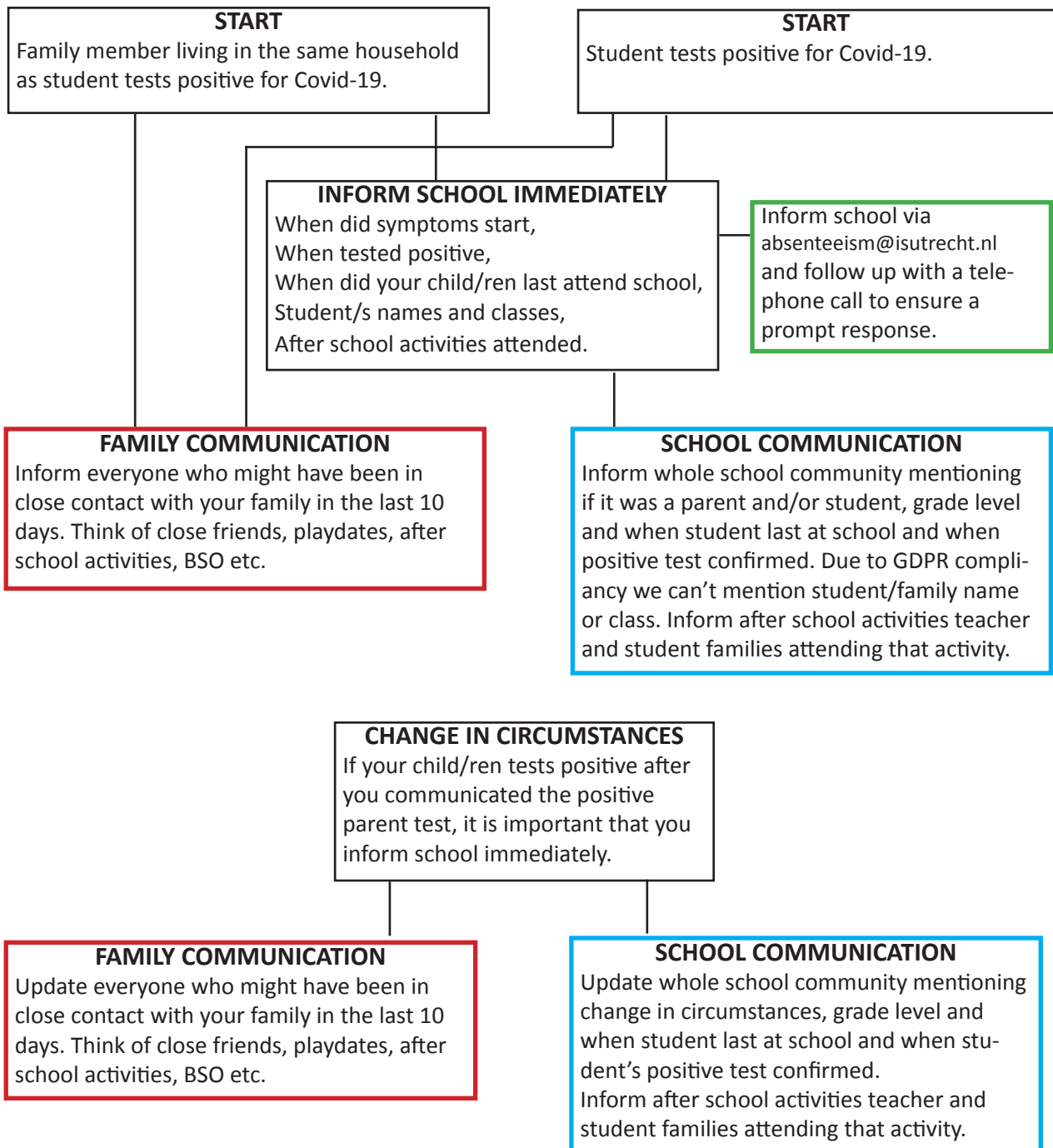


ISUtrecht Covid-19 communication agreement

This protocol should be read alongside the RIVM guidelines as to when and how you and your family should quarantine.



The school will always follow the advice given by the GGD (local health authority) when taking the decision to send students/classes/staff home. Although each positive test result may have different repercussions, there are some general rules:

- When a student is tested positive, in most cases a whole grade level is sent home to quarantine for the advised time. The school will clearly communicate the reasoning behind a different decision.
- When a secondary student is tested positive, secondary teachers can continue with physical teaching if they kept a 1,5 m distance from the infected student. If the teacher has spent more than 15 minutes at a distance closer than 1,5m with the infected student, the teacher will be asked to quarantine for the advised time and teach his/her classes online.
- When a primary student is tested positive, the class teacher will quarantine and work from home for the advised time, as it is more challenging for particularly lower primary staff to keep 1,5m distance from students.
- When a staff member is tested positive, depending on the role of the staff member the school will take appropriate action and we will communicate this clearly.
- The school will only communicate a covid positive case if it has an impact on members of the community. Example, a case during a holiday period when there was no possibility of infection will not be communicated.
